

# CLICK ON CLIMATE



*Click on Climate* is an exciting new action-based program for children aged eight to thirteen. It helps them understand the causes and impacts of climate change and what they can do about it. **The goal of the *Click on Climate* program is to develop conservation practices and other stewardship behaviour in children, so that they will have a reduced impact on climate change. The main tool of this program involves a field trip which takes place in your community.** The program is designed for use by summer camps, youth groups, watersheds and families.

## WHAT DOES THE KIT CONTAIN?

Similar to the *Water Watchdog* Program, each *Click on Climate* kit contains the supplies needed for one leader and five children. The program has been designed with a variety of activities to choose from depending upon your time and learning requirements. Materials in the kit can also be easily copied to accommodate larger groups or allow for its reuse. Each kit contains:

- 1-*Leaders Program Setup Book* containing information on how to plan a *Click on Climate* program.
- 1-*Leader's Field Guide Book* containing instructions for leading activities, tips for success and additional information.
- 5-*Information Files* containing information about climate change.
- 5-*Logbooks* containing journal pages, data sheets and information links.
- 1-*Climate Change Challenge* containing a set of brainteasers which help participants learn about climate change before the field trip.
- 1- *bag of Field Trip Supplies* for the field trip. Other supplies, such as recyclable pop containers, spoons, oranges, and pencils will be needed depending upon the activities chosen.

## HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

*Click on Climate* was developed by the **Partners FOR the Saskatchewan River Basin** with generous support from Environment Canada's Eco-Action and various other foundations. These kits are being supplied to environmental and youth groups **Free of Charge!**
