NSWA has received funding to engage Indigenous communities with reserve, settlement, and traditional lands within the North Saskatchewan River Watershed to utilize eDNA sampling techniques to monitor aquatic invasive species, species at risk, and species of interest. Successful candidates will complete sampling and support community engagement.

- Experience with public engagement is an asset.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills. Proficient with MS Office applications; experience with Adobe Creative Cloud is an asset.
- Knowledge of watershed management and watershed issues.
- Must have a valid class 5 driver's license, a dependable vehicle, and willingness to travel throughout the
